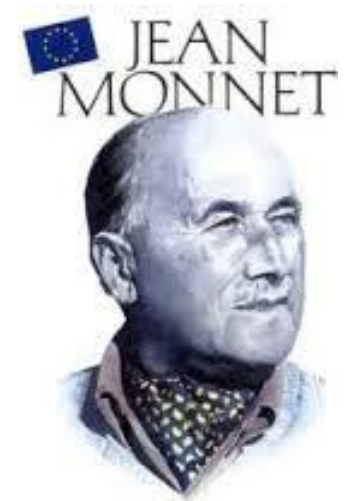

# Historical background

- The Jean Monnet Programme was launched in 1989 aiming to facilitate the introduction of “European integration studies in universities”.
- The programme takes the name of Jean Monnet (1888-1979), one of the ‘architects’ of the European Union, “The Father of Europe”.

<b>Centre of Excellence</b>	<p>Focal point of competence and knowledge on EU subjects based on the expertise of high-level experts.</p> <p>Aims at developing <u>interactions</u> between various disciplines and resources in European studies, creating <u>joint transnational activities</u> and <u>structural links</u> with academic institutions and ensures <u>openness</u> to civil society.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Organizing resources related to European Union studies.</li> <li>- Leading research activities.</li> <li>- Update and complement courses and curricula.</li> <li>- Exchange of experiences about the EU (think-tank function).</li> <li>- Systematic publication of the results of research activities.</li> </ul>		100000 EUR

<p><b>Jean Monnet Support to Associations</b></p>	<p>Jean Monnet supports associations to contribute to the <u>study of the European integration process</u>.</p> <p>They should be interdisciplinary and open to all interested <u>professors, teachers and researchers</u> specialising in EU issues in the relevant country or region.</p> <p>They disseminate knowledge, contribute to collecting and capitalizing information as well as analyzing visions of specific issues.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- e.g. the publication of a newsletter, the setting up of a dedicated website, the organisation of the annual board meeting, the organisation of specific promotional events aimed at providing greater visibility to European Union subjects, etc.;</li> <li>- Publish European Union facts among a wider public enhancing active citizenship.</li> <li>- Perform research in European subjects to advise local, regional, national and European policy makers and disseminate the outcome among the involved institutions in this issues.</li> </ul>	<p>50 000 EUR</p>

<b>Jean Monnet Networks</b>	<p>Foster the creation and development of <u>consortia</u> of international players (HEIs, Centres of Excellence, departments, teams, individual experts, etc.) in the area of EU studies.</p> <p>Jean Monnet Networks require a minimum of 3 partners.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Gathering information, exchanging practice, building knowledge and promoting the European Integration process across the world.</li> <li>-Enhancing cooperation between different HEI and other relevant bodies inside/outside Europe.</li> <li>-Creating a high knowledge exchange platform with public actors.</li> </ul>	300000 EUR
<b>Jean Monnet Projects</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jean Monnet Projects support: innovation, cross-fertilization and spread of European Union content.</li> <li>- Aims: making European Union subjects more attractive and adapted to various kinds of target group; enhance knowledge about the Union and its processes; information and dissemination activities.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Developing and delivering appropriate pedagogical content for School students.</li> <li>- Training and continuing education for teachers</li> <li>-Support the creation of EU Studies and enhance the level of knowledge and the dynamic of a department, staff in a given faculty/school.</li> <li>-Organise conferences, seminars and delivery of courses on EU issues.</li> <li>-Information and dissemination activities.</li> </ul>	60000 EUR

# Call for Proposals 2018

- Call is now opened
- **Deadline for applications: 22 February 2018**
- **Budget:** around € 12 million + € 3 Million for certain Partner Countries
- **Starting date of projects: 01/09/2018**

# How to apply?

- Apply directly to Executive Agency (EACEA)
- Applicants from all countries
- Applicants: HEIs or organisations active in EU subject area
- Only **one** applicant institution is required / except Networks (minimum of 3 partners)

# How to apply?

**Applications must be submitted using the eForm with 3 attachments (Project Description, Budget and Declaration of Honour)**

1. Applicant organisation (for Networks also partner institutions) be registered in Participant Portal and receive Participant Identification Code (PIC)
2. Create official electronic application form (eForm)
3. Fill in eForm
4. Attach completed versions of different attachments to the application-e-form

# Successful Story: Jean Monnet Module

## “EuroMed Relations From Southern Perspective”

- Beneficiary: Cairo University – Faculty of Economics and Political Science.
- Duration: 3 years – 2010 to 2013 with one year extension (auto-finance) 2014.
- Budget: Total Cost: 25.536 euro, the agency co-financed with 19.152 euro.
- Number of Lectures: 60 lectures (3 hours each).
- Number of stakeholders: 90 participants
- Number of instructors: 32 (Egyptian and European Professors, Ambassadors, Experts in the EU Relations).
